Flavian Literature and its Greek Past examines the intimate literary affiliation between the Flavian Greek and Roman authors and their Greek literary predecessors, but also the meaning of this interaction within the socio-cultural context of the Flavian age more broadly. Various panels treat major authors of the period, such as the Flavian epicists, Silius Italicus, Statius, Valerius Flaccus, as well as Martial and Josephus.
